Morse code and radios file folders and ledgers high seas and horizons intersect on his calls as Lir brings orders to tug boats at their docks on the Mississippi. Deck hands drop down ladders as he leaves the "com shack" aboard his destroyer racing through rolling waves. A tug's hand takes the box carried from his warehouse as once a ship's captain received signals from him. On the cold Atlantic now by the warm river his muse still waits for him. He looks across the bow sees her through rising mist as seagulls swirl skyward.
