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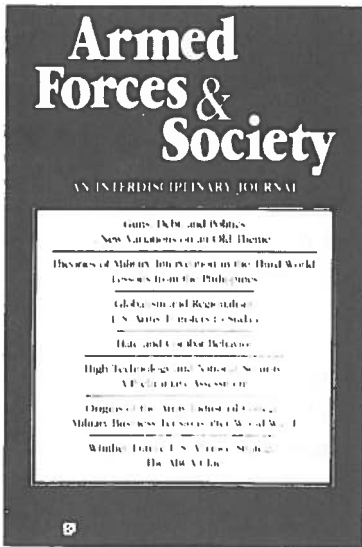
CONSTANCE A. BROWN is Lecturer in English at Barnard College where she teaches a course called "Writers on War." She has completed a book on women writers' response to World War I.
